

Discipleship Pathway Assessment

The first stop on the pathway is a spiritual health assessment. It's hard to know where we need to grow until we first understand where we currently are. This assessment helps us to see how we do in the areas of engaging the Bible, obeying God and denying self, serving God and others, sharing Christ, exercising faith, seeking God, building relationships, living unashamed and acknowledging where we stand doctrinally. It's easy to think we are a lot further along the journey than we really are. As we take this assessment, it will show us where our individual areas of strengths and weaknesses are and hopefully be a catalyst for us to want to grow in those areas.

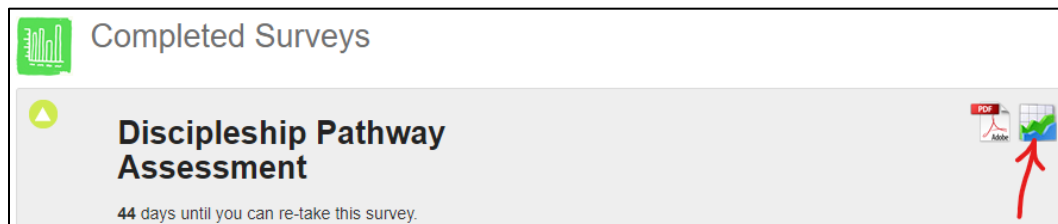
You will notice that the pathway eventually returns to this same point, when you will take the assessment again. The goal, of course, is to see improvement after coming around the circle – to be healthier in our relationship with Christ. The second assessment may also give us new areas on which to focus for we should never plan to be “done” with the journey. Additional suggested materials and resources will be added to help you continue in your spiritual journey.

This assessment is done through a link to Lifeway Resources. Although they do charge a fee, there will be no cost to you, as CCAC has purchased a number of licenses for this purpose.

When you are ready to begin, copy this passcode: **mkbeu6jr4w**
and then go to this link: tdatool.lifeway.com .

Under the “User Registration” heading, paste (or type) the passcode and click Submit. This will step you through creating a user profile with your e-mail address and a password of your choice. From then on, you may log in with your own profile; you will not need the passcode again.

After your registration, you may log in as many times as you wish to review (or continue) your assessment. After logging in, the best review is through clicking the green and blue graph icon as shown here:



This will display each of the signposts and your score. From there, you may click “more” to see the original questions and your answers, or click “Next Steps” to see suggestions on how to grow in that area. Of course, we hope that the steps on the Primary Pathway will be ones you choose to grow with!
